

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION ABOUT AVALANCHE TRANSCEIVERS

Any electronic device has the potential to interfere with the function of any avalanche transceiver.

Any metal object has the potential to interfere with the function of any avalanche transceiver.

The items detailed below have been tested and proven to have the potential to interfere with avalanche transceivers. Any use other than that outlined here is not an option.

The following items are *not allowed* in the field on the heliski trip:

- Electrically heated gloves
- Clothing with magnets (e.g. magnetized zipper flap closures). A magnetic helmet buckle is acceptable
- Cameras or other electronic devices with wireless capability (e.g. GoPro Hero3+ camera). GoPros are acceptable but not in Bluetooth mode while skiing
- Chest mounted cameras or other electronic devices
- Wrist watches with radio functions (e.g. GPS capability)
- Heart rate monitors
- iPods or other music players

The following items must be kept a minimum of 50 cm away from your avalanche transceiver always:

- Radios
- Cell phones (must be in airplane mode)
- Any metal object (even foil food packaging e.g. candy bar)
- All cameras

Guests are welcome to bring chemical hand warmers (2-3 pairs/day) and non-bluetooth heated socks. Please talk with your guide or let us know if you have any questions. Thank you for your support in everyone's safety while in the backcountry.
